

Daily Sales vs Goal






YTD Sales vs. Projection




FY 2020 Total Sales vs. Projection



Rolling 12 Month Total Sales




Rolling 12 Month Sales






Total Sales FY 2019 vs. 2020 vs. Projection






Draw Sales FY 2019 vs. 2020 vs. Projection






Instant Sales FY 2019 vs. 2020 vs. Projection



Draw Sales by Month








Draw Sales by Game









Scratcher Sales by Price Point










Pull Tab Sales by Price Point












FY20 Year-To-Date Financial Status










and sales of these games.

NEW GAME PROFILES

Attached for the Lottery Commission's action are new instant scratch game profiles: *Power 8s* #1260, *100X* #1261, *Lucky Lines* #1263 and *Aces High* #1264.

Power 8s #1260. This \$5 game has a top prize of \$58,000 and will be printed at a quantity of approximately 2.4 million tickets.

<u>100X #1261.</u> This \$30 game has a top prize of \$3,500,000 (30-year annuity) or a one-time cash payment of \$1,750,000. This game will be printed at a quantity of approximately 3.8 million tickets.

<u>Lucky Lines #1263.</u> This \$3 game has a top prize of \$20,000 and will be printed at a quantity of approximately 2.6 million tickets.

<u>Aces High #1264.</u> This \$2 game has a top prize of \$10,000 and will be printed at a quantity of approximately 2 million tickets.

<u>Ruby Red Slots #1042.</u> This \$2 game has a top prize of \$400 and will be printed at a quantity of approximately 270,000 tickets.

<u>Gimme More Money #1043.</u> This \$2 game has a top prize of \$400 and will be printed at a quantity of approximately 270,000 tickets.

<u>Piggy Bank Bucks #118.</u> This \$1 Fast Play game has a top prize of \$1,000. A total of seven numbers are generated and used to identify whether a particular ticket is a winner of one or more instant prizes. A player may win up to five times on a single ticket.
