


Daily Sales vs Goal




YTD Sales vs. Projection

FY 2021 Total Sales vs. Projection




Rolling 12 Month Total Sales






Total Sales FY 2020 vs. 2021 vs. Projection




Draw Sales FY 2020 vs. 2021 vs. Projection



Instant Sales FY 2020 vs. 2021 vs. Projection




FY 2021 Draw Sales by Multi-State & In-State














Arizona Cotteny FY21 Year-to-date Financial Status








Budget by Appropriation Type and Object Class

NEW GAME PROFILES

Attached for the Lottery Commission's action are new instant scratch game profiles: Fast Cash #1311 and Lady Luck #1312.

<u>Fast Cash #1311.</u> This \$1 game has a top prize of \$1,000 and will be printed at a quantity of approximately 3.6 million tickets.

<u>Lady Luck #1312.</u> This \$5 game has a top prize of \$50,000 and will be printed at a quantity of approximately 2.8 million tickets.
