ARIZONA LOTTERY WAIVER OF SERVICE OF PROCESS FOR CERTAIN ANNUITIY COMPLAINTS

PURPOSE

This policy clarifies when the Arizona State Lottery (Lottery) will consider waiver of personal service for certain annuity complaints.

INTRODUCTION

Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.) §5-563(A)(3) prohibits prizewinners from assigning prizes unless pursuant to an appropriate judicial order. Under the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure (A.R.C.P.), the notice of legal action for such an order must be formally served upon the Lottery ("service of process"). In an annuity matter requesting a judicial order for assignment of a prize amount, the Lottery is only a pass-through/quasi non-party and has no case or controversy.

Currently, Lottery's Administrative Counsel (Counsel), who is not in the office every day of the week, should be the only employee to accept service of process on behalf of the Lottery. An informal approach to service of process for non-controversial annuity matters would streamline the process and reduce costs.

POLICY

For complaints to initiate a judicial order for annuity assignment, the annuitant may send the following documents via email to: *annuities@azlottery.gov*.

- 1. A copy of the Complaint,
- 2. A Notice of Lawsuit
- 3. Request for Waiver of Service of Summons Form 1 under Rule 84, A.R.C.P.
- 4. Waiver of Service of Summons Form 2 under Rule 84, A.R.C.P.

All forms shall be completed by the annuitant, pending Lottery signature and return.

In all other cases, proper service of process pursuant A.R.C.P. Rules 4(h) shall be on site and received by Counsel.

RESPONSIBILITY

It shall be the responsibility of the Administrative Counsel to ensure that applicable employees understand and comply with this policy.
