

Arizona Lottery Partner Prize Giveaway Official Rules

Players must be 21 years or older, and have an Arizona mailing address.

The Arizona Lottery's Partner Prize Giveaway must be entered by submitting a comment on the Arizona Lottery's Facebook, Instagram or Twitter posts associated with the giveaway. To be considered, players must tag a friend, local business, or non-profit for the chance to win \$500.

Entries must be made within the Entry Period, which opens on September 13 at 12:00 p.m. Arizona time and closes on September 20 at 11:59 a.m. Arizona time. Players cannot win more than once on Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter. By responding and entering into this giveaway, the Arizona Lottery reserves the right to quote and use the comment across social media platforms and media inquiries.

Once the entry period has ended, ten (10) pairs of winners will be chosen randomly between Facebook, Instagram and Twitter. From the total number of submissions, ten (10) pairs of winners will be randomly selected to each win a \$500 Visa gift card.

Winner(s) will be chosen by a third party from those who made qualified entries during the Entry Period. Any submissions deemed inappropriate by the Arizona Lottery will not be eligible for a prize.

Winner(s) will be contacted via Facebook, Instagram or Twitter private message within 24 hours of the close of the Entry Period by a representative of OH Partners, Arizona Lottery's Marketing Agency of Record, and will have twenty-four (24) hours to respond before their prize is forfeited and an alternate winner will be randomly selected. Prizes from the Partner Prize Giveaway will be mailed to the recipients and recipients will need to provide their full name and Arizona mailing address within the 24-hour claiming period.

The Arizona Lottery has the right to deny entry to any participant, or revoke award to any top prize winner at the sole discretion of the Arizona Lottery.
