



### FY 2022 Total Sales vs. Projection










### Total Sales FY 2021 vs. 2022 vs. Projection






### Draw Sales FY 2021 vs. 2022 vs. Projection






### Instant Sales FY 2021 vs. 2022 vs. Projection






### FY 2022 Draw Sales by month







#### FY 2022 Draw Sales by Game



### Arizona Lotteny Scratcher Sales by Price Point





### Arizona Cottery Pull Tab Sales by Price Point





### **Transfer Amount by Beneficiary**





This report has been provided to the Lottery Commission regarding game profiles planned for Arizona Lottery instant scratch games. The Commission is requested to approve these game profiles. After Commission approval, staff will commence with plans for printing, distribution, and sales of these games.

### **NEW GAME PROFILES**
