#### Call to Order

1. Call for Quorum: Pursuant to the Public Notice dated November 9, 2022, the Public Meeting of the Arizona State Lottery Commission was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Chair Jeff Weintraub.

A quorum was present, with Chair Weintraub, Commissioner Katsel, and Commissioner Thomson appearing via teleconference.

- 2. **Notice:** Notice was posted by Luanne Mansanares on November 14, 2022, at 1:50 p.m., at the Arizona State Lottery, located at 4740 E. University Dr., Phoenix, Arizona.
- 3. Approval of Minutes: Chair Weintraub entertained a motion to approve the minutes of the October 21, 2022, Public Meeting. Commissioner Katsel verbally moved; Commissioner Thomson verbally seconded. The vote was unanimous with Chair Weintraub verbally voting aye, Commissioner Katsel verbally voting aye, and Commissioner Thomson verbally voting aye. The motion carried.

10:04am Commissioner Crump joined the meeting via teleconference.

#### **Agency Reports**

- 1. **Director's Presentation**: Director Edgar presented information on the beneficiary focus of the month, Habitat for Humanity Northern Arizona, and provided financial information generated by the world record Powerball® jackpot. Director Edgar concluded his presentation with election information pertaining to the Governor elects transition and the launch of two new Arizona Lottery products; Ultimate Playlist and Lucky Lounge. The presentation is attached for the official minutes.
- 2. **Financial Report Presentation**: Russ Harben introduced Brian Hemmerle from Henry+Horne. Mr. Hemmerle presented Henry+Horne's audit report on the Arizona Lottery's financial statements. Russ Harben finished the presentation with the current financial results. Providing information on the overall sales, new projections, and financial status with a comparison of last year's sales. The presentation is attached for the official minutes.

Commissioner Katsel commented that the Arizona Lottery transitions smoothly when sharing incredible news about exceeding sales projections. Commending the Arizona Lottery on an extraordinary job by exceeding the sales projections. Director Edgar thanked Commissioner Katsel for her comments and informed the Commission that the Arizona Lottery is very proud of all of its accomplishments.

3. New Games Introduction – No Presentation

#### **New Business**

1. Chair Weintraub opened the discussion of the future election of the Commission Chair and Vice Chair

Director Edgar informed the Commission that the Arizona Lottery would like to move forward by placing it on the January Commission agenda. To nominate and elect a new chair and vice chair.

Sherri Zendri clarified to Chair Weintraub that all discussions must be made publicly and may not be discussed amongst themselves.

Chair Weintraub informed Sherri Zendri to clarify he would never talk privately and no more than two members would ever get together privately without notice.

Commissioner Julie Katsel informed the Commission that her term is ending and she will not be in a position to serve in a leadership role in this upcoming year. Director Edgar informed Commissioner Katsel that the Governor's office is working on a replacement and thanked her for her service. Chair Weintraub informed Commissioner Katsel that she will be difficult to replace and we appreciate your service.

Commissioner Trent Crump informed the Commission that he has given notice and will be stepping down as Commissioner at the end of the year. Director Edgar informed the Commission that the Governors' office is also working on a replacement for Commissioner Crump's law enforcement position and thanked him for all his efforts

during this difficult time. Commissioner Crump informed the Commission that he would stay on until a replacement has been found.

Commissioner Katsel asked if there is a term limit on the Chairmanship and if it's possible to re-elect the current Chair because he is doing such a great job. Director Edgar informed the Commission that there is no term limit and it is a possibility as long as the chair is willing.

Chair Weintraub stated that the election of Chair and Vice Chair will be on the agenda next month and continued discussion with the next agenda item

2. Chair Weintraub asked if any members of the public wanted to address the Commission regarding new instant scratch game profiles: \$50,000 Lucky Dog #1403, Wild Cherry Doubler #1405, Mystery Multiplier #1407, Bingo Star #1408, and Cash Drop #1409. There were no responses from the public.

In accordance with A.R.S. §5-554(C), Chair Weintraub entertained a motion to approve the orders and authorize the Director to issue the orders regarding new instant scratch game profiles: #1403, #1405, #1407,#1408 and #1409. Commissioner Crump verbally moved; Commissioner Thomson verbally seconded. The vote was unanimous with Chair Weintraub verbally voting aye, Commissioner Katsel verbally voting aye, Commissioner Thomson verbally voting aye and Commission Crump verbally voting aye. The motion carried.

3. Chair Weintraub asked if any members of the public wanted to address the Commission regarding new promotion profile: *Multiplier Mania 2023* #122. There were no responses from the public.

In accordance with A.R.S. §5-554(C), Chair Weintraub entertained a motion to approve the order and authorize the Director to issue the order regarding new promotion profile: #122. Commissioner Katsel verbally moved; Commissioner Thomson verbally seconded. The vote was unanimous with Chair Weintraub verbally voting aye, Commissioner Crump verbally voting aye, Commissioner Crump verbally voting aye, Commission Katsel verbally voting aye. The motion carried.






## **Daily Sales vs Goal**




## YTD Sales vs. Projection

#### FY 2023 Total Sales vs. Projection




## **Rolling 12 Month Total Sales**


#### **Rolling 12 Month Sales**



#### Total Sales FY 2022 vs. 2023 vs. Projection




#### Draw Sales FY 2022 vs. 2023 vs. Projection



#### Instant Sales FY 2022 vs. 2023 vs. Projection




#### FY 2023 Draw Sales by month














## Arizona College FY23 Year-to-date Financial Status




