











Daily Sales vs Goal




YTD Sales vs. Projection

FY 2023 Total Sales vs. Projection




Rolling 12 Month Total Sales






Total Sales FY 2022 vs. 2023 vs. Projection




Draw Sales FY 2022 vs. 2023 vs. Projection



Instant Sales FY 2022 vs. 2023 vs. Projection




FY 2023 Draw Sales by month







Arizona Cottemy Scratcher Sales by Price Point








Arizona Cotteny FY23 Year-to-date Financial Status




