




Daily Sales vs. Goal





YTD Sales vs. Projection






Rolling 12 Month Total Sales





















Draw Sales by Month










Sales by Price Point - Scratcher and Pull Tabs














Transfer Amount by Beneficiary







FY24 Year-to-date Financial Status






